



Group 1 and 2 was tasked to present their proposal at the top of the site, being situated at the most elevated point of the terraced levels. With this being said, it was the ideal opportunity to place a view point. Allowing one to be able to view and assess the entire organic district. The first Terrace is adjacent to Belmount Terrace Street, and in close proximity to the church. Through the analysis obtained from local residents, movement frameworks and behaviour patterns, it was concluded that the 1st terrace would best house the market in which organic produce would be sold. The 2nd terrace would house the restaurant and café facilities, which would offer a variety of organic food grown from the Urban Farmville. 

44 strand street

The main focus of the 44 Strand street project is to resurrect the old and abandoned Steve Biko House. The project will give new life to this building of historical significance; to a bruised beauty that has been tortured by a dark past. The concept is reshaping the past on looking towards the future by means of incorporating natural light into the building through a system that channels sunlight from the top to the bottom. There are three main sections, namely the memorial on the bottom floor which represents the dark past, the school of architecture in the middle which represents the progression towards the future and lastly, a technology expo housed on the top floor which represents the future.
